I've been keeping the grounds looking good and doing repairs inside the Legion. Let me know if you notice anything that needs to be done, leave a note behind the bar.


Thanks to **Dave Ferron** for supplying the chicken wire to fix the fence and **Chris Scott** for helping me put it up.


remember them.
